# **EXAMPLE Project Summary**

EXAMPLE Nonprofit seeks a \$2,000 grant to fund a comprehensive search and rescue operation for a missing person in Example City and State, USA. The funds will support the costs of search equipment, volunteer coordination, and essential supplies necessary for the operation.

### **EXAMPLE Project Description**
